SUMMER LECTURE SERIES



On Wednesday, August 9 at 6:00pm, guest lecturer **David S. Isenberg** will speak on the topic of "Net Neutrality." David founded isen.com to rethink the value of communications network in an era of technological abundance.

He spent 12 years at AT&T Bell Labs until his 1997 essay, "*The Rise of the Stupid Network*" was received with acclaim everywhere in the global telecommunications community with one exception - at AT&T itself! So Isenberg left AT&T in 1998 to found isen.com, LLC (*an independent telecom analysis firm*) and to publish "The SMART Letter" an open-minded commentary on the communications revolution and its enemies.

The FCTV Summer Lecture Series takes place at the studio of Falmouth Community Television (FCTV), 310 Dillingham Ave, Falmouth. The series is free and open to the public but we do request a minimum donation of \$5 per person. All lectures will be videotaped for cablecast on channel 13 in Falmouth.

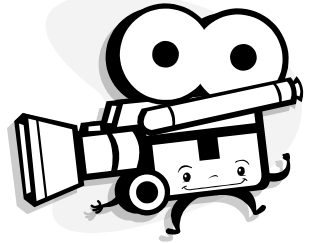

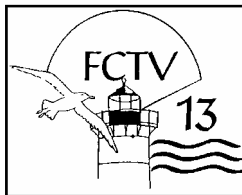
