## FCTV CAPITAL CAMPAIGN 2006 WE NEED YOUR SUPPORT!

In the fall of each year we appeal to you, our members, businesses, community groups, non-profit organizations and the Falmouth community at large, to ask for your financial support by donating to our Capital Campaign. If you have donated to FCTV's Capital Campaign in the past, thank you, we appreciate your generosity and hope that you will continue to support us this year. If you have never contributed to FCTV, now is the time and we ask that you please consider making a contribution.

FCTV is a non-profit 501 (c3) public charity so donations are tax deductible. And, because FCTV is local, your donation remains here, in our community, allowing us to provide you with the best services, equipment and local programming possible. This means sports, community events, government meetings and more!

Each year when we ask for donations to support equipment purchases, we also ask for your suggestions. We listened, and in 2005 we purchased equipment totaling over \$22,000 to keep FCTV on the technological cutting edge and to continue to meet the needs of our members and viewers. The list of equipment purchased in 2005 is long and includes: LCD monitors, DV Recorder, hum eliminator and new character generator for Control Room A; a navy velour curtain for Studio A; headsets for field productions; Apple iLife 05 suite which includes iPhoto, iMovie, iDVD and Garage Band, DVD Recorders, LCD Monitor, encoding equipment, video capture boxes, audio mixers and DV/SVHS recorder for our non-linear editing suites; microphones for recording voice and musical performances; laptops that when connected to a digital camera sends a wireless signal to our production van or to FCTV from up to 3,000 ft. away; a hard drive that eliminates the use of videotape in the field and a computer that enables FCTV to stream Channel 13 live 24 hours a day.

Thanks to your donations and with our live streaming capability you never have to miss a moment of programming on FCTV no matter where you are in the world. Your support also allows FCTV to continue to be a leader in the world of community television.

In 2006 we intend to make purchases that will make our editing suites more efficient and user friendly. We are also looking at technology that promises to bring FCTV even further into the new media revolution. To get there, we need your help.

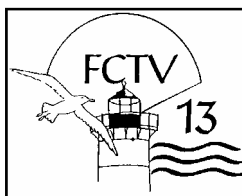
