Meet New FCTV Volunteer Producers Jean Valtierra & Anne Leavitt

Jean and Anne joined FCTV this spring. They have already taken Basic Field Production and produced their very first show entitled "People for Cats."

The show is named after the local non-profit organization that is a non-kill shelter for cats of all ages. Cats entering the shelter are brought to a local vet and are provided with applicable shots and spayed or neutered if needed.

Jean and Anne joined FCTV to produce a monthly program for People for Cats. They hope to raise community awareness of the need to control the feral population, to showcase kittens and cats that are available for adoption, and to remind current pet owners to have their pets spayed or neutered. The first episode will highlight the manner in which to "trap" or catch a stray cat so that it is harmless to the animal.

Currently there is a great need for volunteers, young and old who can visit the shelter, even if it's only for 10 or 15 minutes, just long enough to hold or pet some of these lonely cats in need of homes.

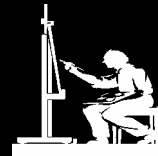

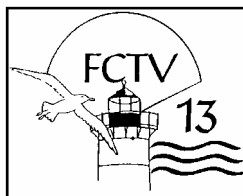
