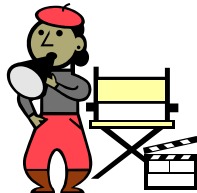

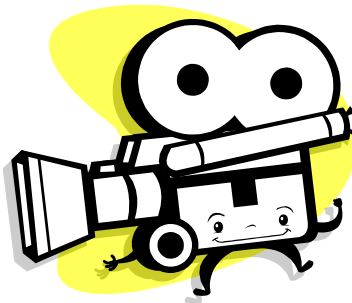
YOUR VIDEO ON THE INTERNET

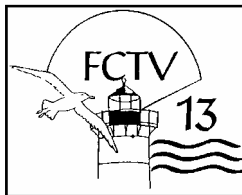
