- All funding to continue to be received directly by FCTV.
- Explanation of how you use FCTV and how that use impacts you, your community group, department or organization.

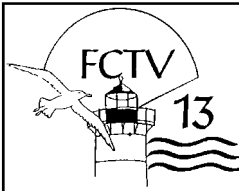
