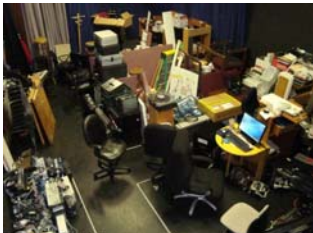

MyMassTV.org KICKOFF EVENT AT STATEHOUSE

On January 14, 2009 MassAccess, the state chapter of the Alliance for Community Media held a kickoff of www.MyMassTV.org at the statehouse in Boston.

MyMassTV.org is the first of its kind in the nation: a civic network that will distribute TV programs from state and regional government agencies, and elected officials to offer vital public service information to all Massachusetts residents at no charge over one website and available to all municipalities over their local community TV channels.

Several dignitaries spoke on this exciting project and the enormous impact they anticipate it will have in opening up communications between state and regional government and individual citizens. Governor Deval Patrick was on hand to lend his support and spoke enthusiastically about this project, which he is already using. Other dignitaries in attendance included Representative William Brownsberger, Secretary of Elder Affairs Mike Festa, Representative Karyn Polito, State Production Manager James Day and Joe Landolfi, Communication Advisor to Governor Deval Patrick.

FCTV is a user site for this server and FCTV viewers can expect to see an increase in state programming on our local channel in the coming months.

ALLIANCE FOR COMMUNITY MEDIA NE REGION RETREAT

Over the weekend of January 16th, The Northeast Region Board of Directors of the Alliance for Community Media (ACM-NE) held a strategic planning retreat in Ogunquit, Maine.

FCTV's Executive Director, Debra Rogers who is the vice chair of the ACM-NE and the Region Representative to the National Board of Directors attended. The planning was led by Nantz Rickard a long time ACM National Board Member, Public Policy leader and Director of DCTV in Washington, DC. Nantz is also currently attending Law School and Interning at the offices of Spiegel and McDiarmid, LLP in Washington with Jim Horwood, the Alliance's legal advocate.

"We on the Regional Board of Directors recognize that we are in a critical juncture for access and it was time to evaluate what we have accomplished, what path we take next and how to best allocate resources to achieve the goals we prioritized. This region has, over the years been a leader nationally as well as regionally and so great consideration was given to the fact that decisions we made would impact other regions, national and most importantly must serve our local constituents. Discussions revolved around who we served and how to best allocate resources to serve these constituents given our human capital

as well as financial resources. We came out of this retreat with a very specific plan which focuses on communication, education and advocacy. The associated tasks which are now in committee or assigned to working groups will be implemented over a two year period and evaluated annually" states Debra.

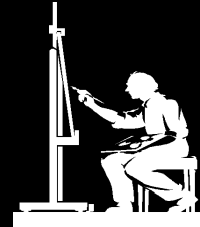

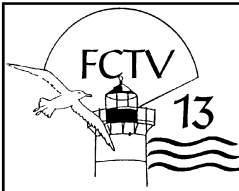
